

Adult Social Care County Team

This is an exciting permanent opportunity to join a newly created team in Oxfordshire, initially for a period of 12 months, on the understanding that when the team disbands, your post will be integrated into the locality Teams.

We will endeavour to support staff to work in their preferred geographical area, but you will need to be able to travel and offer some flexibility. The priority areas for assessments, at the moment, are in the North and South of the County.

However, the expectation will be that you attend the teams base at Knights Court for meetings and supervisions.

Staff will be encouraged to use the strength - based approach and will be part of a dynamic team, with the satisfaction of seeing results, as the waiting list numbers and times reduce. This in turn supports colleagues in the Locality Teams by enabling them to focus on a more manageable waiting list.

You will have some autonomy in planning your workload and contributing to this important piece of work, with the result of providing better outcomes for people by seeing them in a timelier way and providing the opportunity to work towards more independence.
