



FREE early education for 2 year olds

Some two year olds within Oxfordshire are eligible for up to 15 hours of free early education and childcare a week. Check the back of this flyer to see if you are eligible to apply for a place.

Early education and childcare is great for children. They can learn through play, make new friends, try different activities and get a good start to education.





Are you eligible?

To be able to apply for a free early education place one of the following must apply:

1. You are in receipt of one of the following benefits:
 - Income Support
 - Income-based Job Seekers' Allowance
 - Income-related Employment and Support Allowance
 - Support under Part VI of the Immigration and Asylum Act 1999
 - The Guaranteed element of State Pension Credit
2. Your family receives working tax credits and has an annual gross earning less than £16,190.
3. Your two year old child has a current statement of special educational needs or an education, health and care plan; or attracts Disability Living Allowance (DLA).
4. The two year old is currently in the care of the local authority (Looked After Child) or has left care through special guardianship or an adoption or residence order.
