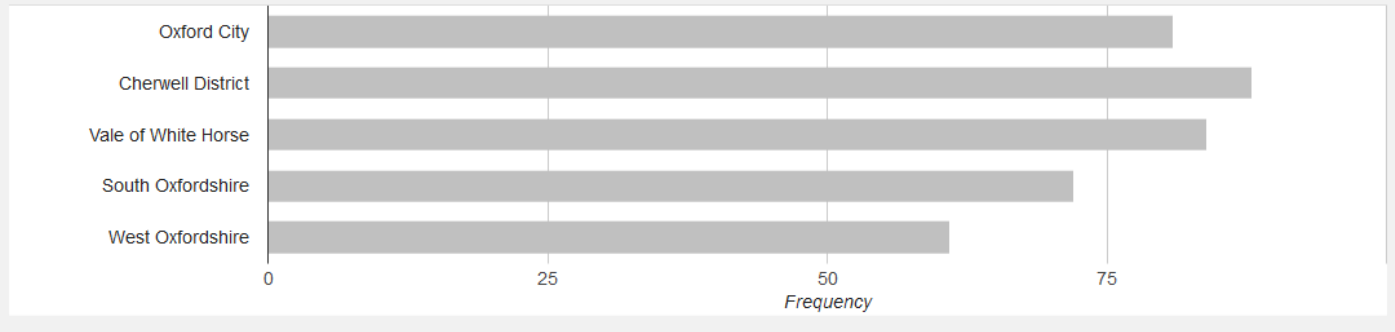
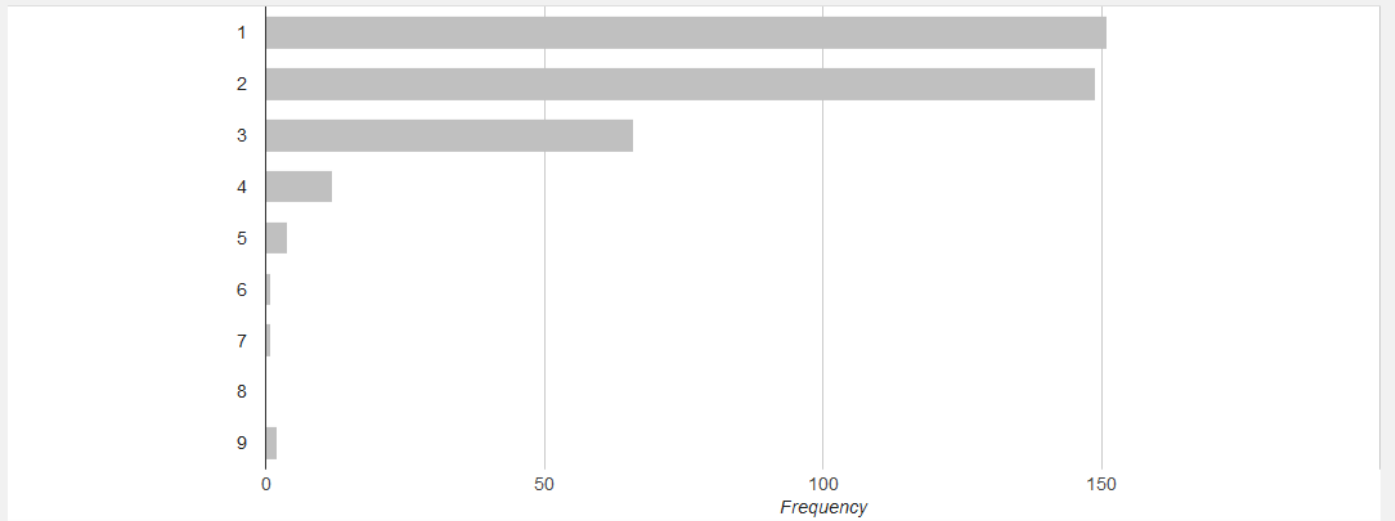

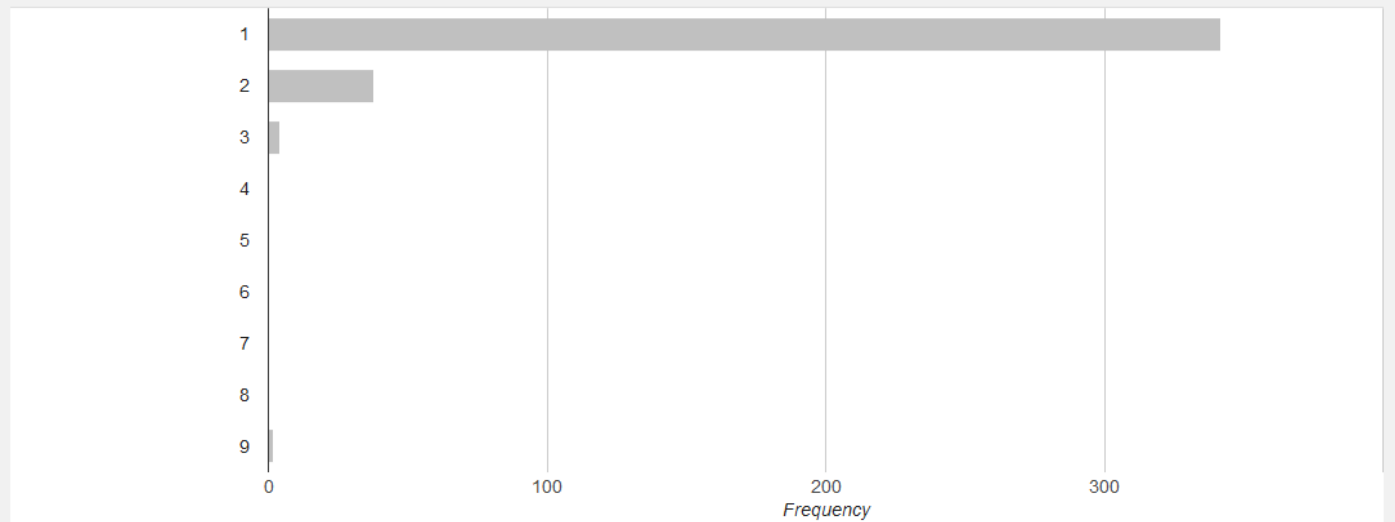
Where do you live?



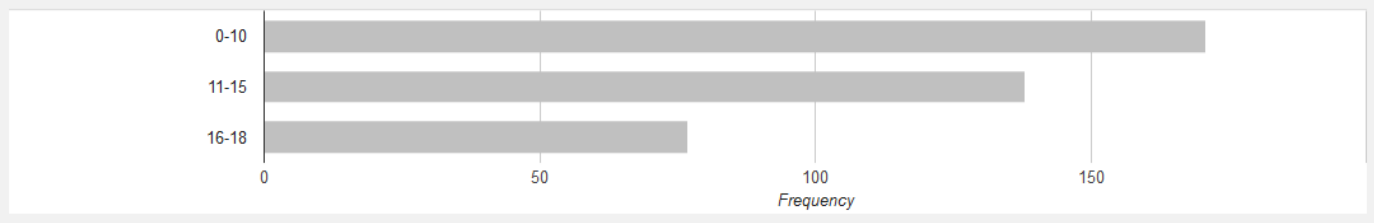
How many children (under 18) are you the principal carer or parent to?

What is the age of the child with a disability that you care for?



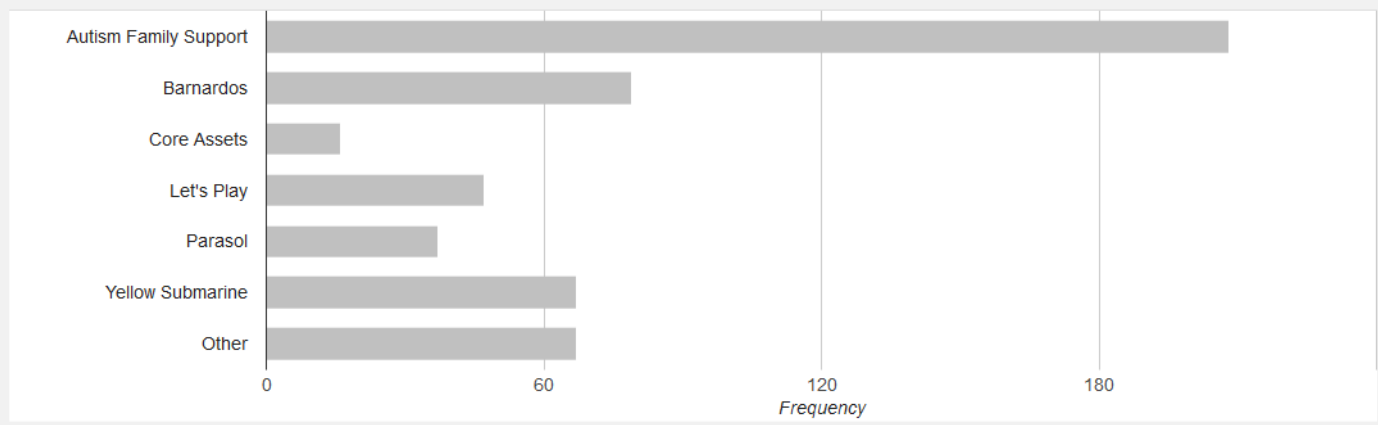
When attending specialist services or activities does this child?

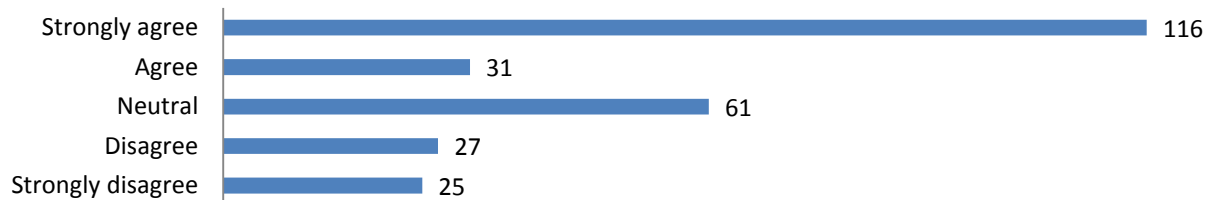

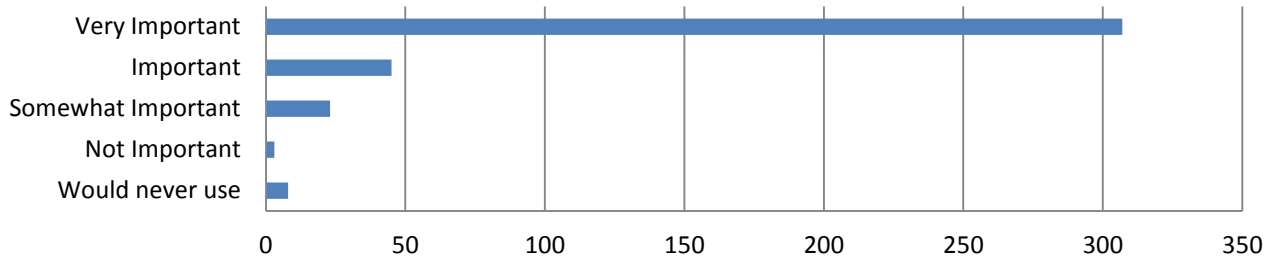

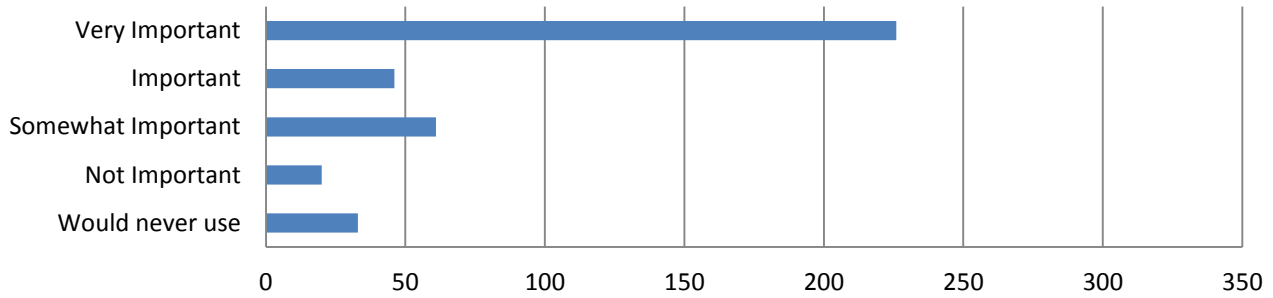

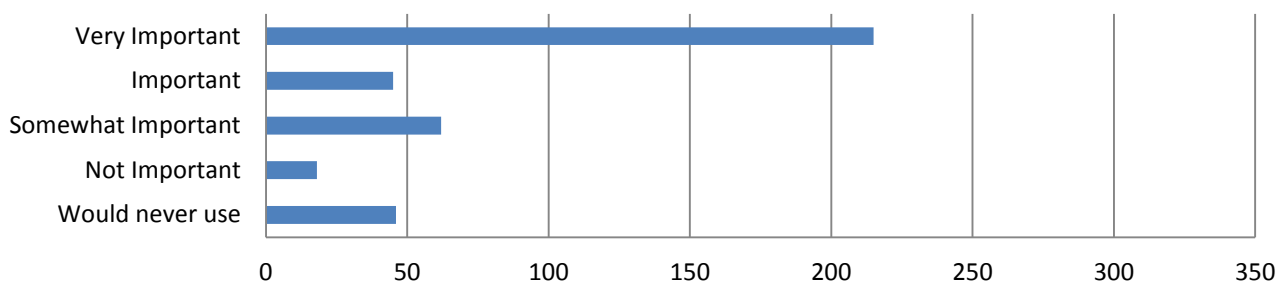
How important is the provision of activity days in the school holidays?

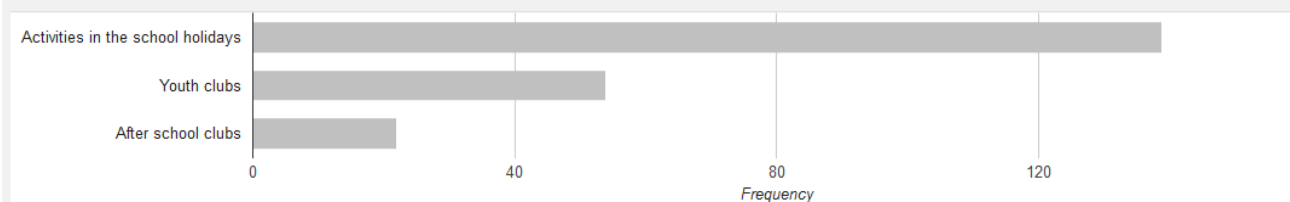
