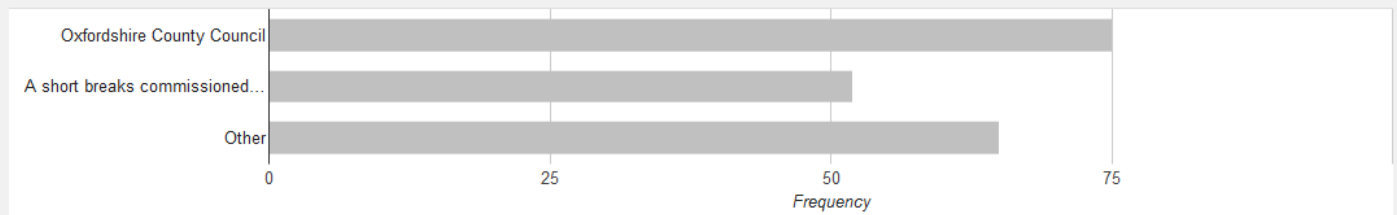


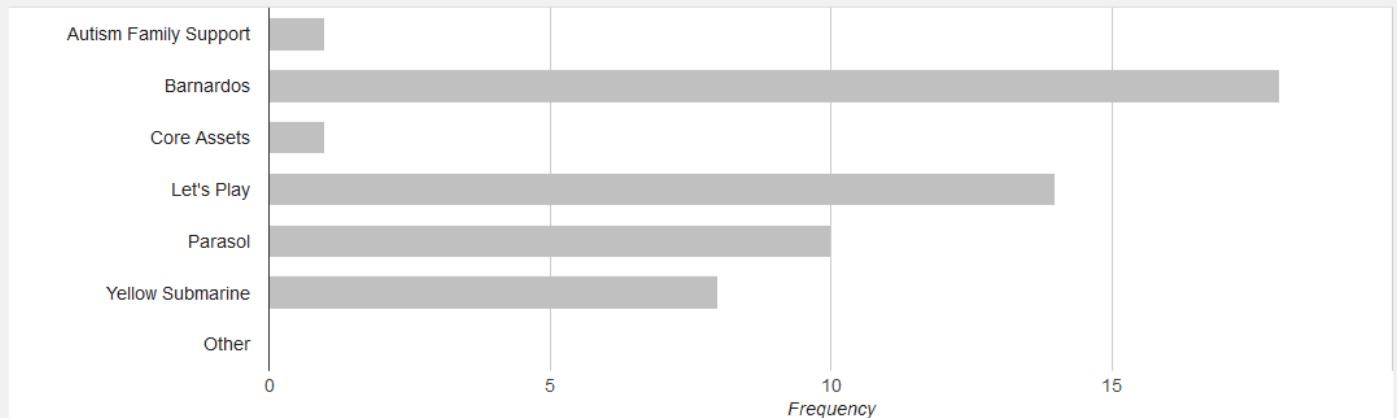

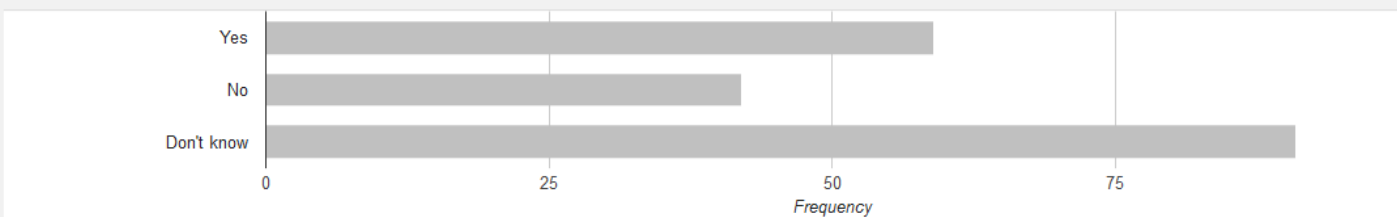
Who do you work for?

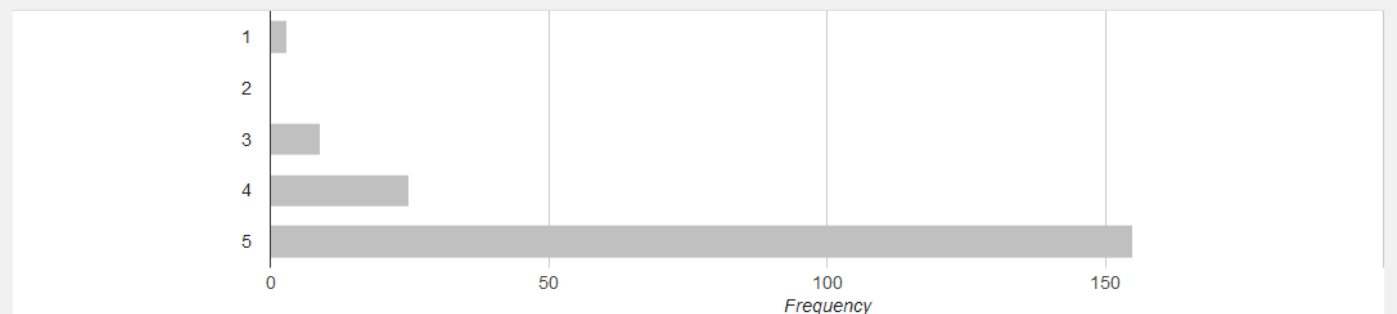
It is vital for the welfare of children and young people with disabilities that "out-of-school activities" continue to run in Oxfordshire.

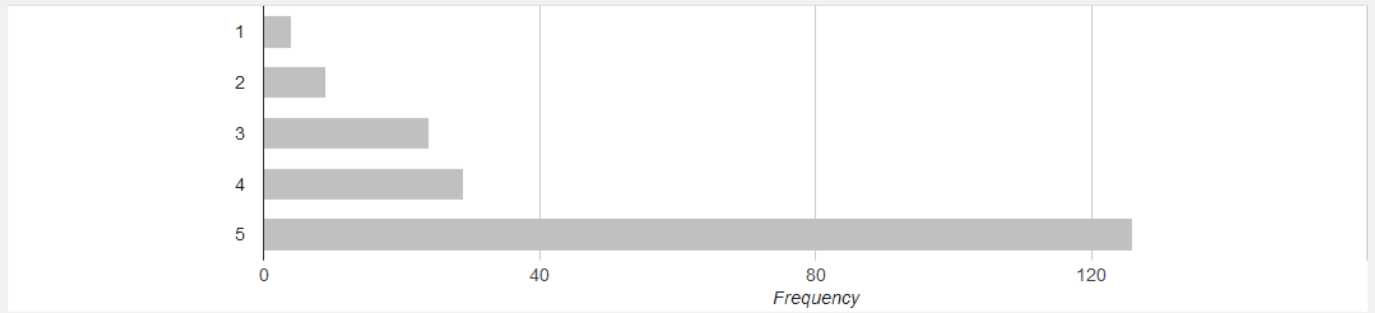

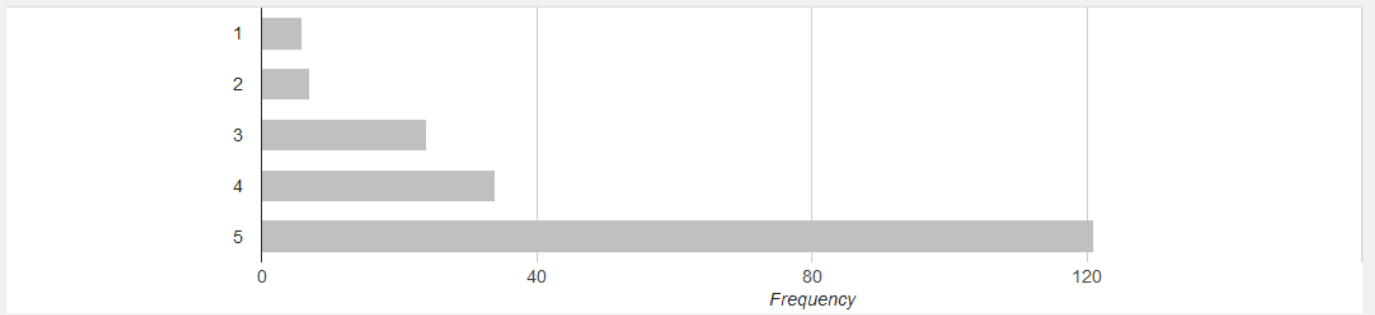
How important do you think it is for the county council to commission the provision of 'activity days' in the school holidays?



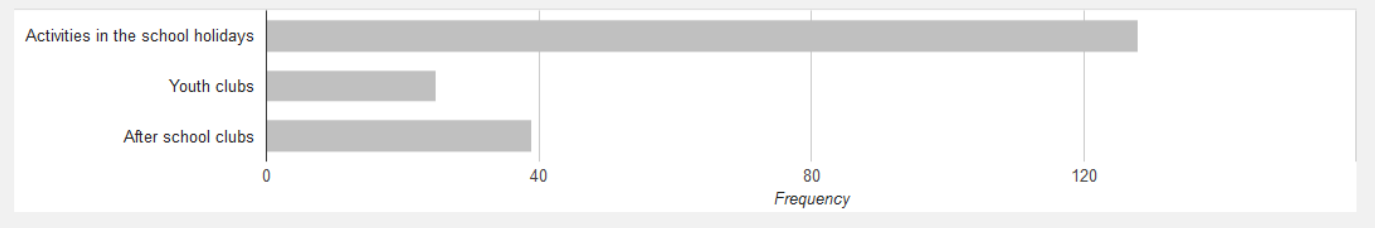
How important do you think it is for the county council to commission the provision of 'youth clubs'?
