

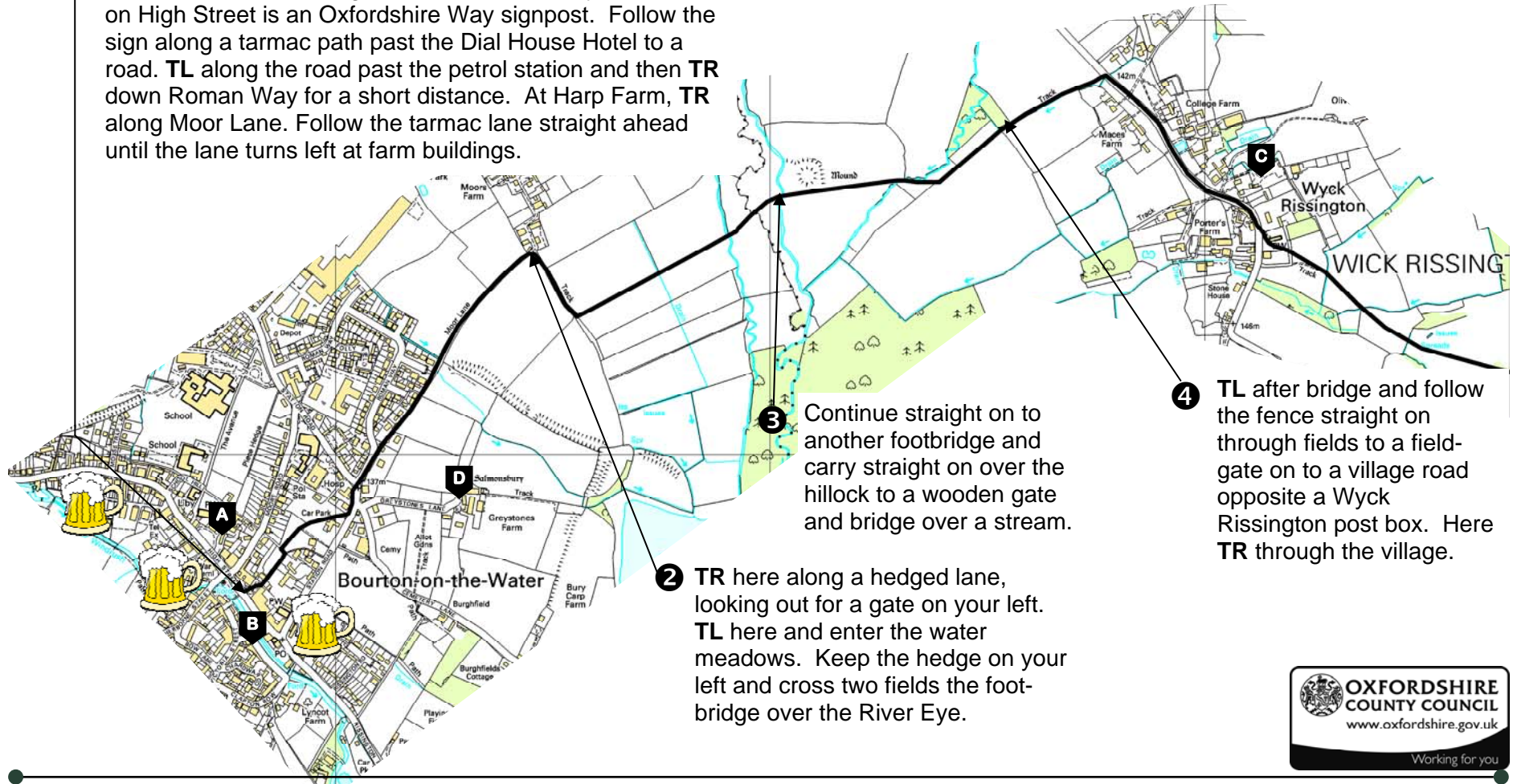
Oxfordshire Way Map I—Bourton-on-the-Water to Bledington I (Bourton-on-the-Water to Wyck Rissington)

Approximately 2 miles (3 km)



TL= Turn Left FL = Fork Left BL = Bear Left
 TR = Turn Right FR = Fork Right BR = Bear Right

1 The Oxfordshire Way begins on the High Street which has the aqueduct running alongside it in the centre of Bourton-on-the-Water. To the right of the model railway exhibition on High Street is an Oxfordshire Way signpost. Follow the sign along a tarmac path past the Dial House Hotel to a road. **TL** along the road past the petrol station and then **TR** down Roman Way for a short distance. At Harp Farm, **TR** along Moor Lane. Follow the tarmac lane straight ahead until the lane turns left at farm buildings.



2 **TR** here along a hedged lane, looking out for a gate on your left. **TL** here and enter the water meadows. Keep the hedge on your left and cross two fields the foot-bridge over the River Eye.

3 Continue straight on to another footbridge and carry straight on over the hillock to a wooden gate and bridge over a stream.

4 **TL** after bridge and follow the fence straight on through fields to a field-gate on to a village road opposite a Wyck Rissington post box. Here **TR** through the village.
