We are residents of Bampton and thoroughly object to the proposal for gravel extraction in Clanfield / Bampton .

<u>Traffic</u>

All the roads in the area are narrow and out of the villages there are no footpaths making them hazardous for pedestrians, cyclist and horseriders and therefore totally unsuitable for use by more large and heavy vehicles.

There are already an increasing number of large vehicles using these roads, with construction lorries and farm equipment becoming larger all the time.
