I have seen the Gardner Representation produced by Gardner Planning on behalf of OXAGE and fully support the points made. The report is a damning critique of OCC's approach, which has caused mounting concern over a number of years. It is more concerned with getting its own way – for reasons that are opaque – than achieving what is best for Oxfordshire. Of particular concern is the sudden increase in projected need for more extraction, when, as Gardner points out, adoption of the 10-year average method would indicate a small surplus of reserves and no need for any new sites. There seems a clear determination to foist extraction on South Oxfordshire despite very clearly determined arguments against it already made by CAGE and supported by the Planning Inspector. The new figures have been obtained by consultation with mineral producers in a process that apparently excluded consultation with local parish councils and the general public, which means that it does not legally comply with the Statement of Community Involvement. The new Plan fails, however, to be clear about potential sites, another dereliction of legal duty that can only suggest that OCC is aware of the weakness of its own position whilst pursuing at all costs its own agenda – using tax payers' money.
