

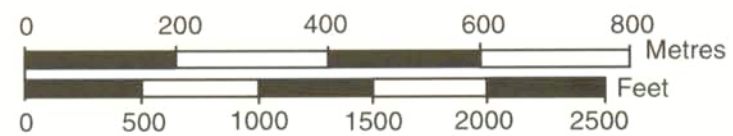
# Inset Map 5 Caversham area

- Area permitted of already worked (old workings are only shown where an after-use is indicated).
- Area where planning permission for mineral working will not normally be granted (see policy PE2 paragraph 4.3).

After-use categories set out below:

- ③ nature conservation;
- ⑥ low key water-based activities – windsurfing, sailing;
- ⑦ intensive water-based activities – water-skiing, jet skiing, windsurfing, sailing (see paragraph 4.45).

Where several after-uses are allowed, these are stated in order of priority. Other after-uses may also be allowed but they must not conflict with the primary aims in any area. In all cases opportunities to protect and enhance nature conservation features will be pursued. All after-use proposals must be appropriate to the local area and must comply with environmental (including Green Belt) and other relevant policies of district local plans.
