faith and in earthe of the church of Englande and  
also of Irelande under god the supreme head, to  
the reverende father in god the Bishoppe of  
Exeter in the Kinges said ma<sup>ties</sup> Visitation 1547

¶ Your self shall to yo<sup>r</sup> uttermost power, witt, and understanding  
see and cause all evy and singular the Kinges injunctions heretofore given  
or hereafter to be given from tyme to tyme in and throught yo<sup>r</sup> diocesse  
Duchye, tounche, and faithfully to be kept, observed, and accompyshed

¶ You shall personally preache in yo<sup>r</sup> diocesse every quarter of the yere  
once at the least, that is to saye, once in your Cathedrall church and  
thrice in thre other severall places of your diocesse, wheras to yous  
shall seme moste convenient and necessary except yous have a  
reasonable excuse to the contrarye

¶ You shall not retayne in to yous p<sup>ar</sup>ce or householde any chylde  
for a chappellain, but such as be leaured and able to preache the wordes  
of god, and whos yous shall cause to receive the same

¶ You shall not give ordres to any person or persons not being  
leaured in holic scripture, neither dunge thern that be leaured  
in the same and be of honest conversation and living
