

# Children & Young People

**We welcome all children and young people to Oxfordshire Libraries and we want their visits to be safe and happy**

## Parents' Responsibilities

- Babies and children of Preschool age must be **closely supervised** at all times.
- Children of Primary School age must be **supervised** at all times and their parents must be present and within easy reach. You are expected to ensure they comply with the Library Acceptable Use Policy.
- Children and young people of Secondary School are able to use the library independently but must ensure they comply with the Library Acceptable Use Policy.  
(However, parents should note that library staff and volunteers are **not** acting in “loco parentis”)
- Children of Primary School age attending closed events may be left unattended by parents by agreement with the organiser.
- Class visits must be supervised by school staff and teachers who should be present and within easy reach at all time.
- If you wish to take photographs or film your children in the library please agree this with the organiser first.
