What is Bike Safe?

BikeSafe is a national police led initiative, that seeks to increase riders' awareness and create a genuine desire to learn about safer riding.

In the Thames Valley

Thames Valley Police covers the counties of Buckinghamshire, Berkshire and Oxfordshire however; you don't have to live in the Thames Valley area to book a BikeSafe workshop with us.

What is the cost?

The course costs £50 per person for the day and can be booked via the BikeSafe website or by telephone. You can also buy gift vouchers for someone you think may benefit from BikeSafe. Courses are open to anyone with a full motorcycle licence and have no more than 12 attendees on each course.

What can you gain?

Our aim is simple, to reduce motorcycle casualties. In a one day workshop we offer some solutions to the most common causes of collisions, assess your riding and give you realistic and practical advice to move on to advanced training. This will enable you to get more enjoyment from your riding while aiming to make you a smoother and safer rider.
