2. Occupational Therapist

You can request an assessment of your needs from your local Social and Community Services team. There may be a waiting list for an assessment. In some cases they may be able to help you to access funding for the installation of an accessible shower. Please contact the Social and Health Care Team for further advice/information **before** you start any adaptation work, as funding is **not** available retrospectively:
