Enabling people with a learning disability to live as independently as possible.

The Community Learning Disability Teams are a group of social and health care professionals who work with adults who have a learning disability and their families/carers.



The teams work with individuals and their support networks on a referral basis. We offer flexible and personalised services which could include:

- Full health needs assessments
- Full social needs assessments and facilitation of individualised budgets
- Care planning, treatment and review
- Care management (housing, support, day services)
- Health promotion (e.g. good health groups)
- Supporting families and carers
- Support with mental health issues
- Teaching and training direct care staff
- Facilitating use of community and main stream health services
- Working with people with behaviour that challenges others



Who provides the support?

We work as a fully integrated multi-disciplinary team which is made up of highly trained clinical and social care professionals including:
